

Job Description for Sunday Night Discussion Group Leader

1) Principal Function

To facilitate an engaging discussion with a small group of students to help the students process, understand, apply the truths taught in the teaching session, and function in the role of a **Supervisor** (See separate Supervisor Job Description for details)

2) Specific Duties

- a) Commit to attending Frontline Sunday Night Large Group Meeting from 6-8pm on a weekly basis.
- b) You will lead a discussion for 10-30 minutes. The length of this will depend on things such as: time available, topic, need to teach vs. need to discuss, etc.
- c) You will be given an outline of questions/topics to cover one week in advance with the biblical answers. The goal is to get through each question and discuss the biblical application. Obviously sometimes this doesn't happen due to good in-depth discussion of first questions.
- d) Spend time in prayer beforehand with other discussion group leaders.
- e) Get every student involved and answering.
- f) Give students time to think about the question before calling on someone. Sometimes students may receive questions beforehand, sometimes not. This will depend on the lesson.
- g) Provide an environment where students feel safe to state their opinion.
- h) Close in prayer; take prayer requests if you feel led.
- i) Plan to stay after Youth Group 15-30 minutes in case students want to discuss things further with you.
- j) Come alongside and mentor an assistant who is a college age leader to become a good discussion group leader. Your goal is to train this assistant to be qualified to lead a group at some point in the future.

3) Skills Required

- a) Has a deep & personal relationship with God and understands, lives out, and can communicate the exchanged life.
- b) Relational - Loves people, particularly has a heart for youth.
- c) Willing to serve.
- d) Willing to learn.
- e) Good at asking questions and leading discussion, or desiring to grow and develop in this 😊
